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
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Provide services to its members:

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Aims 1995

- undertake joint inspection and evaluation projects to promote partnership and cooperation between the inspectorates

SICI should

- support improvement of inspectorates and the professional competences of inspectors.
- promote and support partnership and cooperation between inspectorates.
- actively participate in the international debate about school evaluation and quality of education.

We achieve these goals

- through supporting the development of skills and methodologies.
- through joint inspection and evaluation projects and other ways of cooperation.
- by providing knowledge gained in inspections to policy and decision makers.

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
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
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
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Transparent description of tasks and roles
