- A school achieves required outputs in chosen subjects of the curriculum (the Czech and English language, mathematics) during a set period (three-year period) according to SEPs and it takes measures in accordance with findings of its self-evaluation of results
- A school monitors the overall and group success of children, pupils and students in accomplishment of education during a set period (three-year period) and it takes measures in accordance with findings of its self-evaluation
- A school monitors effectiveness and success of systems implemented in the area of the Safety and Health Regulations, the prevention of risk behaviour and school failure. It takes measures in accordance with findings of its selfevaluation
- A school uses findings of external evaluation of education results (e.g. it uses the opportunity of comparing results with other schools at regional, national or international level)
- A school publishes results (e.g. on its website)
- A school follows with interest the career of its graduates (during their further studies, job career)
